SCA Cares for Suffield

Food Assistance

We delivered **8,808** meals to **67** homebound individuals, an increase of over **1,000 meals** since the prior year. Our food pantry saw **480** visits last year, feeding over **100** Suffield families.

Senior Care

We provided transportation and adult daycare subsidies totaling **\$8,794** and increased funding for medical programs by over **31%**. We sponsored more than **1,700** meals for low-income seniors.

Housing Assistance

We contributed **\$100,047** to low-income residents through our Housing Repair Program, making their homes safer, more secure, and accessible.
